LOCATION

The 2nd Annual Wing Eating Competition will be held in the northwest parking lot of the John Q. Hammons Convention Center at the Embassy Suites of Northwest, Arkansas.

OFFICIAL RULES

1. Each contestant must sign the Risks and Waiver Liability section and the Official Rule section of this form and turn into the Official Judge and show proper identification (Drivers License).
2. Each competitor will be given a tray of pre-weighed wings, with equal parts drummy and flats
3. The contest will be three (3) minutes exactly.
4. Start and finish will be announced by the Official Spokesperson of the contest.
5. Competitors must not touch wings before the announced start or after the announced finish.
6. Once start is announced, competitors must finish each wing, drummy or flat, that is taken out of the tray before discarding back in the tray. A maximum amount of one (1) wing, drummy or flat, is allowed in each hand at all times.
7. Once finish is announced, competitors must put wings in hand back in their tray.
8. Once finish is announced, competitors must finish eating wing meat in their mouth.
9. Regurgitation or vomiting is grounds for disqualification during the contest and after the contest until winner is announced.
10. Competitors must consume all meat off the bones before they are given additional wings, both drummy and flats.
11. Competitors must put all bones/debris back in their designated tray during the contest. Debris/bones not placed back in the tray during contest are grounds for disqualification. Any water or anything else spilled in the tray will be counted as official weight at completion of the contest. It is advised to eat over the tray and drink over the table.
12. Once the contest is complete, each competitor's tray will be picked up and weighed by the Official Judge on an official contest scale.
13. The winner will be determined by the total weight of wing meat eaten and announced concluding the weigh in.
14. In the event of a tie, there will be a sixty (60) second "run off" to determine the winner.
15. Any contingencies or disputes that may occur before, during or after the contest that are not explicitly listed in the official rules, the Official Judge's decision will stand with the same finality as the rules. The Official Judge has full responsibility for any grounds of disqualification.

RISK & WAIVER OF LIABILITY

I acknowledge there are inherent risks associated with the above described activity and I assume full responsibility for personal injury and further release and discharge The Poultry Federation and anyone or anything involved with this event.

In so doing, contestant releases and indemnifies the aforesaid entities and individuals in this contest or the receipt or use of any prize. In no event shall The Poultry Federation be liable to a contestant for acts or omissions arising out of or related to the Contest or that contestant's participation in the contest.
